## STANDING ORDER NO. 115 /2006

Subject: Deployment/utilization of IRB/HAP forces!

Memo 4155-56 Dedo 62-6666

The aim of this Standing Order is to tende deployment/utilization of IRB/HAP forces while they are deployed in districts for law and order duties.

- 1) It is noticed that HAP/IRB personnel are divided into ones and two and are deployed in Police Stations, Police Posts and for other general duties. Purpose of deploying Armed Police in district as enhance the strength of district armed reserves. It is not desirable and distribute such reserves among sub units.
- 2) It is expected that all the normal and routine police datas on the districts are discharged by the district police without the help of additional reserves from outside. However, when armed police reserve are given to a district such force shall stay in the Police Lines one shall remain under the command and control of their own platfood, orapered Commanders. They shall be responsible for providing the required number of personnel everyday to the district Lines Office, to deployment. Requisition for such deployment shall be wanted. Commander/Platoon Commander of the force by Lines Officer
- Normally each reserve shall consist of one NGO, three HCs and twenty-four Constables and each Coy, shall consist of 3 such reserves
- The Coy. Commander/Platoon Commander shall ensure that minimum 80% of the reserve personnel are provided to the district policevery day for duty. The armed reserve personnel deployed in districts are not to be granted long leave and if any leave is granted substitutes shall be provided by Bn Hgrs. However casual leave and weekly offs may be sanctioned depending upon situation. Such wastage shall be adjusted in the 20% leave reserve mentioned above.
- 5) The HAP/IRB reserve personnel may be deployed on
  - a) Centralized day/night patrolling along with local police
  - b) Naka duties along with local police.
  - c) Prisoner escort duties along with local police.
  - d) Strike reserves.
  - e) General bandobust duties.
- 6) The HAP/IRB force shall not be deployed on following duties

- Postings at Police Stations, Police Posts or in the DPO. Range offices.
- Surveillance duties.
- Conducting searches and raids independently.
- iv) Assisting investigation of cases in special units viz CLA. Women Cell etc.
- v) Summon/warrant duties.
- vi) Gunman/PSOs.
- vii) Static guards at residences, treasuries and other places.
- The Coy Commander/Platoon Commander HAP/IRB reserves shall be responsible for organizing PT and games for the personnel everyday. These reserves shall attend Monday and Friday parades in the Police Lines along with district police. The SP of the district shall be responsible for organizing parades in the Police Lines on every Monday and Friday.
- 8) The Distt SP shall provide suitable accommodation and other facilities to HAP/IRB, reserves in the Police Lines. The IRB/HAP reserves shall carry their own mess arrangements.
- 9) The IRB/HAP reserves deployed in districts shall be equipped with long/short lathis, helmets, cane-shields and body protectors by the Commandant concerned. However if they are to be armed, the arms and ammunition shall be provided by the district SP for the duration of the duty period and the weapons shall be issued by name from the District Kot and Arms and Ammunition shall be immediately deposited back in the District Kot after the duty. Before men are assigned armed duties, the platoon commander shall ensure that the personnel to whom such duties are assigned are proficient in handling of such weapons.
- 10) The IRB/HAP reserves deployed in districts, shall be substituted every three months by the Bn Commandant to ensure periodic training of personnel at Bn HQtrs.
- 11) To prevent absenteeism and furlough, while deploying IRB/HAP reserves to various districts the Bn Commandants shall ensure that no personnel are sent on temporary duty deployment to their Home Range. Prior clearance of ADGP/CPT&R in case of IRB and of ADGP/IG for HAP shall be taken if such deployments are unavoidable.
- 12) When deployed on Naka/patrolling duties, the armed reserve personnel shall work under the supervision of a NGO or senior Head Constable of district police. Care shall be taken to ensure that NGOs and HCs who are senior to the armed police NGO or HC only are put in charge of them.
- by SP concerned to the respective Commandant and copies shall be sent to IG/Range, IG/HAP, IG/CPT&R and Ops Branch/PHQ.
